Privately funded by the Duke of Buccleuch and designed by globally-renowned landscape artist Charles Jencks, Crawick Multiverse is a stunning representation of exciting discoveries and theories of the universe.

This world-class landscape art design links the themes of space, astronomy and cosmology, creating a truly inspiring landmark that will appeal to everyone from art enthusiasts and scientists to the wider community. Now run by a charity, the Crawick Artland Trust, all proceeds from your visit go towards maintaining the site for future years.

Crawick Multiverse is situated just off the A76 (Dumfries to Kilmarnock), 25 miles north of Dumfries (approximately 45 minutes by car) and 15 miles from the M74 at Abington (approximately 30 minutes by car).

Sanquhar railway station is just one mile from Crawick Multiverse. There are also regular bus services from Newcastle, Carlisle, Kilmarnock and Glasgow.
